This is the last Will and testament of me Elizabeth Drayson of Towcester in the County of Northampton Widow I give devise and bequeath all my lands tenements and Hereditis in Litchborough and Pattershill and elsewhere unto my two Sons William Drayson and Thomas Drayson their heirs and Assigns as tenants in common Subject to and charged with the payment of the sum of One thousand Pounds of lawful British Money which I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Sindry Drayson her Executors Administrators and Assigns to be paid to her within six calendar months with Interest for the same from the time of my decease at the rate of five pounds per cent per annum And I give and bequeath all the residue of my personal Estate which shall remain after the payment of my just debts funeral and testamentary expences unto the said William Drayson Thomas Drayson and Elizabeth Sindry Drayson equally to be divided between them In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of November One thousand Eight hundred and fifteen Elizth Drayson
