yeare of our Lord one thousand sixe hundred fitye and sixe I  
Paull Pitchley of Wellingborowe in the Countie of Northton  
mercier beinge sicke in bodeye but of perfect minde and  
memorie (praised be Almightye God for the same) doe make  
and ordaine this my last Will and testament in manner and  
forme followinge (that is to saie) ffirst I Comend my Soule to  
Almightye God my heavenlie ffather And my bodie to bee  
interred in the earth in Christian buryall at the discretion of my  
freinds Item I give and bequeath unto my Loveinge Mary  
Bayley a Legacie of ffive shillings of lawfull English money Item  
I doe give and bequeath unto my Loveinge Wife Mary Pitchley  
all my goodes Cattells debts and chattells unbequeathed To her  
free dispose Item I doe make and ordaine my said wife Mary  
the Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In wittnes  
whereof I the said Paull Pitchley have hereunto sett my hand  
and seale Dated the day and yeare first above written Paull  
Pychley Signed sealed and published in the presence of Mary  
Bennett her marke John ffreeman Scr
